

Washington – Today, Congressman John Olver (1st-MA) announced that he has signed a disclosure bill.  
"The fact that the Republican leadership is refusing to schedule a vote on this bill is another example of the obstructionist tactics that have become the norm in Washington."  
The clandestine 527 groups can secretly accept unlimited amounts of money from unlimited sources.  
"Already this year, we have seen the practice of secret attacks on candidates by 527 groups exploiting the loopholes in the current law."  
Spurred on by Senator McCain (R-AZ), the Senate voted 57-42 to close the 527 loopholes.
