

WASHINGTON—Today, Congressman John W. Olver (D-1st District) announced that the Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) has awarded a grant to the North Adams Housing Authority to improve all four of its public housing developments. The funding is awarded annually, and is part of HUD's Capital Fund Program (CFP). "The Capital Fund Program is an approach that allows local authorities the flexibility to address their unique needs," said Olver. The money will be used for interior and exterior modernization for the four federal housing developments.
