

Washington - Today, Congressman John Olver (1st District) announced that the final version of the Transportation and Infrastructure Appropriations Act that will serve the Fitchburg area. The bill includes \$2 million that will go toward a parking garage in downtown Fitchburg that will serve the Fitchburg area. "Commuter rail service is a vital transportation link for North Central residents that would allow them to get to work and school more easily. I am proud to have secured this funding for the Fitchburg area. Olver serves on the Transportation Subcommittee of the Appropriations Committee, and he is currently working on the bill.
