

WASHINGTON, D.C. , Congressman John W. Olver (D-1st District) scored 100 percent from the Leader

The LCCR Voting Record reflects positions taken by every senator and representative on the legislative

The priorities for the 109th Congress include judicial appointments, voting rights, hate crimes, education

Olver's score is particularly significant during a time when both the White House and Congress are Rep

While Olver's score solidly reflects the priorities of LCCR, the organization states in its scorecard, "Over

"The loss of broad support for civil rights issues is a direct result of the fact that only a few Republicans

Founded in 1950, LCCR is currently made up of nearly 200 organizations representing persons of color
